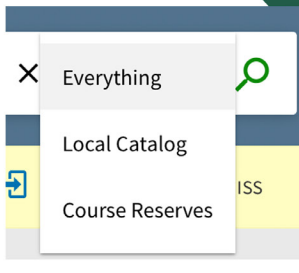

2 Everything v. Local

Search the "Local Catalog" for descriptions of items in the Carleton and St. Olaf libraries, such as books, e-books, journals, and DVDs. "Course Reserves" is for finding course readings put on reserve. Select "Everything" and search the catalog descriptions plus full text articles from journals, newspapers, and streaming media,

When you log in to Catalyst you can request books from other Bridge libraries, see saved items, and renew and see your account items you currently have checked out.
